



MRI PREPS

All Contrast studies: Nothing to eat or drink 4 hours prior the exam. You may take small sips of water to take medications.

PLEASE REVIEW THE MRI CONTRAST CONSENT FORM AND MULTIHANCE MEDICATION GUIDE INFORMATION PRIOR TO YOU APPOINTMENT.

All MRI Patients: Please contact the imaging department at 540-785-7200 prior to your appointment if any of the following apply:

- If you have any metal in your body
- If you have any shunts, stents, pacemaker/defibrillator, aneurysm clips or coils
- If you have any tattoos less than 8 weeks old
- If you have any work related or accidental metal in eyes or elsewhere
- If you have any medication patches or pumps
- If you have any type of internal or external surgical implants
- If there is a possibility you are pregnant

*Please note: If patient has any of the following, the patient will need labs (BUN and Creatinine) within 30 days prior to the procedure:

- 70 years or older
- Diabetic
- High Blood Pressure
- Kidney Disease
